During the process of repairing a dump valve all wells were switched to one FWKO which pressured up and the fluid was released from the man way gasket. Immediately switched back to the other FWKO. A vacuum truck was dispatched to pick-up standing fluid.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

The release was Approximately 4,000 square feet with Approximately 2,000 square feet was released into the pasture west of the facility. A vacuum truck was dispatched and recovered 30 barrels of fluid. The area was mapped and initial field samples collected from the surface.
