

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

The power supply was interrupted, causing the pumps not to start and the tanks to overflow. Vacuum truck(s) were called.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

An approximate area of 91' X 15' was affected north of the battery string, and an approximate area of 57' X 37' was affected east of the battery string within the bermed battery. Called an electrician to restore power to the pumps, a contractor to fix the warning alarms; vacuum truck to remove standing fluid, and a backhoe to excavate impacted soils. Excavated soils will be hauled to a NMOCD approved facility. Vertical and horizontal delineation samples will be taken and analysis ran for TPH & BTEX (chlorides for documentation). If initial analytical results for TPH & BTEX are under RRAL's (site ranking is 0) a Final Report, C-141 will be submitted to the OCD requesting closure. If the analytical results are above the RRAL's a work plan will be submitted to the OCD. Depth to Ground Water: >100' (approximately 360', Section 4, T20S-R24E, per Trend Map), Wellhead Protection Area: No, Distance to Surface Water Body: >1000', SITE RANKING IS 0.
