Chris,

After reviewing the above spill event and the analyticals, I would like to proceed as follows:
The top portion, areas S-9, S-10, and S-11 should be treated with a Micro Blaze type treatment to reduce the TPH. I would like to have the initial treatment and a second set of samples taken in 60 days. If needed a second treatment just prior to the monsoonal flow (late June, early July). As for flushing the upper portion, I don't see a benefit at this time with the chlorides as low as they are.

The lower portion has some higher chlorides showing up, but still low enough to not be an issue. A good rain event or two would take care of the remaining chlorides. The poly line that was left in the lower portion can be removed. Please contact Jeff Pangburn, archaeologist (APAC), prior to removal, as they are to assure no additional disturbance to the arch sites.

Let me know when the upper portion is to be treated, and if any questions.
