Cliff,

I didn't realize the flow path was that long. However, as I understand it, the proposal is to remove 1' of impacted material all the way along the flow path, as practicable. If that is correct, OCD would not require the surface sample analysis from SP 7, as that material is going to be removed. The 1' sample from SP 7 was well within closure limits. I would suspect BLM will require confirmation samples prior to backfilling any of the excavation. Since the flow path is so long, I would request maybe 3 or so sample points be established at intervals along the flow path (excavation) just for confirmation, after excavation.

I am just sending this to you, but if you need to distribute, feel free.

Mr. Brunson,

In reviewing your soil sample analysis, there was only one sample taken in the pasture, sample point #7. I did not find any analysis at sample point 7 for the surface; there was just a sample at 1 foot depth.

As you can see from the attached spill map, the spill on this location ran over 1,000 feet out into the pasture. Do you have any other sample data from the spill path after it left the pad?
