Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. has requested to amend Division Order No. PLC-373-D to include the wells listed in Attachment No.1 to the surface commingling order. The Division has reviewed your application and hereby grants your request.

The Division Order No. PLC-373-D is hereby amended, and Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. (OGRID 282327) is hereby authorized to surface commingle gas production from the pools and the diversely owned wells listed in Attachment No. 1, located in Sandoval County, New Mexico.

Gas production from each well shall be separately metered before commingling with production from other wells. The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.
