Lucky 13 Federal Com. Well No. 7 H (API No. 30-025-42612), Unit J, Section 13, T-25S, R-33E.

The project area for these wells include the W/2 NE/4 of Section 13, W/2 SE/4 of Section 12, and SW/4 NE/4 of Section 12.

The oil and gas production from these wells shall be measured at, and sold from, the Lucky 13 Federal Com. Well No. 6 H and Lucky 13 Federal Com. Well No. 7 H shared well pad Central Tank Battery located in Unit J of Section 13, Township 25 South, Range 33E East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. All meters for the above-referenced wells shall be physically separated from facilities for other wells, so that production from the above-referenced wells will not be commingled prior to measurement with production from any other well.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:
