Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. (OGRID 6137) is hereby authorized to surface commingle oil and gas production from Jabalina; Delaware, Southwest Pool (97597) from the following leases and wells in Lea County, New Mexico:

Lease: Federal lease NMNM100568
Description: E/2 E/2 of Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, NMPM
Well: Mean Green 23 Federal Well No. 1H

Lease: Federal lease NMNM100568
Description: E/2 E/2 of Section 26, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, NMPM
Well: Mean Green 26 Federal Well No. 1H

The combined project area for these wells include the E/2 E/2 of Section 23, and the E/2 E/2 of Section 26, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

The commingled oil and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Mean Green 23 Federal Well No. 1H Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit P, Section 23, Township 26 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:

The oil and gas production from each of the diversely-owned leases shall be separately metered using allocation meters.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The operator shall notify the Hobbs District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
