Pursuant to your application received on August 17, 2015, XTO Energy Inc. (OGRID 5380) is hereby authorized to surface commingle gas production from the following pools located in Section 11, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico;

Basin Fruitland Coal (Gas) (71629)
Blanco-Mesaverde (Prorated Gas) (72319)

and from the following diversely owned wells located on a federal lease in said Section, Township, and Range in San Juan County, New Mexico:

Little Stinker Well No. 2	30-045-31570	2	E/2

The commingled gas production shall be measured and sold at the Little Stinker Well No. 2 and L.C. Kelly Well No. 6 shared central tank battery (CTB) located in Lot 2, Section 11, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, San Juan County, NMPM, New Mexico.

The gas production from each of the diversely-owned leases shall be separately metered using allocation meters.

The allocation meter shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2) NMAC.

Subsequently drilled wells that produce from the subject pool within the project areas approved by this order may be added to this commingling authority by submittal of a Sundry Notice to the Engineering Bureau in Santa Fe.

The operator shall notify the transporter of this commingling authority.

The operator shall notify the Aztec District Office of the Division upon commencement of commingling operations.
