

ExxonMobil Production Company respectfully submits the attached the C-141 Release Notification and Corrective Action Report for remediation activities completed at our Avalon Delaware #238 location. The 83 bbl. produced water release occurred on July 28, 2009 and has been remediated per the approved Revised Remediation Plan (EPI Reference Number 190037). In accordance with the approved plan, approximately 2,600 cu. yds. of impacted soil was excavated and sent to a waste disposal facility.

At three foot below ground surface:

- A 12,800 sg. ft. 40-mil polyethylene liner was placed over the bottom of the excavation
- A one foot layer of soil, free of deleterious material, was placed beneath the liner
- A two foot layer of clean top soil was placed over the liner for protection from heavy equipment

Remaining corrective activity includes the seeding of the disturbed area. However, due to the extreme drought condition seeding operations will be delayed until spring 2012.

It is our understanding that the submission of the attached C-141 and Remediation Closure Report provided by Environmental Plus Inc. fulfills ExxonMobil Production Company's responsibility. This work has been done on behalf of USP at its discretion. We respectfully request a No Further Action for the July 28, 2009 release (NMOCD Tracking: 2RP-349).
