Reference is made to your request, dated December 15, 2015, on behalf of Devon Energy Production Company, LP for a six-month extension of the January 31, 2015, deadline to commence injection into the above named well for reasons outlined in the attached correspondence.

It is the Division's understanding from your request that there have been no significant changes in the information provided in the application submitted for review and approval of this order. These changes include the completion of new wells within the Area of Review that penetrated the approved injection interval and any changes in ownership.

The deadline to commence injection for the existing order is hereby extended until July 31, 2016.
