Re: <u>Denial of Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water</u>

Applicant: Cortez Trucking LLC

Dear Mr. Cortez:

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) <u>hereby denies</u> your Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water for the following reasons.

I. Applicable OCD Rules:

OCD Rule 19.15.34.9 NMAC states in relevant part:

19.15.34.9 DENIAL OF A FORM C-133: The division may deny approval of a form C-133 if:

D. the applicant or an officer, director or partner in the applicant, or a person with an interest in the applicant exceeding 25 percent, is or was within the past five years an officer, director, partner or person with an interest exceeding 25 percent in another entity that possesses or has possessed an approved form C-133 that has been cancelled or suspended, has a history of violating division rules or other state or federal environmental laws; . . .

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OCD Rule 19.15.34.10 NMAC states:

19.15.34.10 CANCELLATION OR SUSPENSION OF AUTHORIZATION TO MOVE LIQUID WASTES: A transporter's vehicular movement or disposition of produced water, drilling fluids or other liquid oil field wastes in a manner contrary to division rules is a ground for denial of approval of form C-133 in addition to the those specified in Subsection D of 19.15.34.9 NMAC. It is also cause, after notice and an opportunity for hearing, for the division to cancel or suspend a transporter's authorization to move liquid wastes.

II. Relevant Facts:

In the Summer of 2009 the OCD investigated a complaint of a produced water release that occurred, on or about June 22, 2009, from one of the water transport trucks of the company that you owned and operated as Cortez Trucking and Oilfield Service. The release occurred in a residential area. According to you, 60 barrels of produced water was released from the truck. You indicated that the release occurred when one of your employees was rinsing out the tank of a water transport truck at your residential property. The release flowed down your driveway and alongside the shoulder of the roadway outside your property where it destroyed a neighbor's grassy area. According to you, you dug up the soil and disposed of it at your ranch. You said you were in the business of transporting produced water, and admitted to regularly transporting produced water, even though you did not have an approved Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water.

III. Violation of OCD Rules

a. <u>Transporting Produced Water Without an Approved Form C-133</u>
Authorization to <u>Move Produced Water</u>

OCD Rule 19.15.34.8(A) NMAC states:

A person shall not transport produced water, drilling fluids or other liquid oil field waste, including drilling fluids and residual liquids in oil field equipment, except for small samples removed for analysis, by motor vehicle from a lease, central tank battery or other facility without an approved form C-133, authorization to move liquid waste. The transporter shall maintain a photocopy of the approved form C-133 in the transporting vehicle.

You violated OCD Rule 19.15.34.8(A) NMAC when your company, Cortez Trucking and Oilfield Service, was transporting produced water without an approved Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water.

b. Unauthorized Disposition of Produced Water

OCD Rule 19.15.34.11 NMAC states in relevant part:

Except as authorized by 19.15.30 NMAC, 19.15.17 NMAC, 19.15.36 NMAC, 19.15.29 NMAC or 19.15.26.8 NMAC, persons, including transporters, shall not

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dispose of produced water or other oil field waste:

- (1) on or below the surface of the ground; in a pit; or in a pond, lake, depression or watercourse;
- (2) in another place or in a manner that may constitute a hazard to fresh water, public health, safety or the environment; or . . .

You violated OCD Rule 19.15.34.11 NMAC when your company willfully released produced water onto the ground in a residential neighborhood.

c. Not Timely Reporting Release or Completing Corrective Action

OCD Rule 19.15.29 NMAC requires persons who operate or control the release or the location of the release to report to the OCD the unauthorized release of produced water or other oilfield waste that occur during drilling, producing, storing, disposing, injecting, transporting, servicing or processing. OCD Rule 19.15.29 NMAC has certain notification requirements for major and minor releases. The 60 barrels release was a "major release" under OCD Rule 19.15.29.7 NMAC ("Major release' means an unauthorized release of a volume, excluding gases, in excess of 25 barrels.'"). OCD Rule 19.15.29 NMAC requires persons to give immediate verbal notification to the OCD of a major release within 24 hours of discovery, and written notice by filing a Form C-141 Release Notification and Corrective Action within 15 days. OCD Rule 19.15.29.11 NMAC requires the responsible person to complete division-approved corrective action for releases that endanger public health or the environment.

You did not provide timely notification of the release to the OCD as required by OCD Rule 19.15.29 NMAC. You only provided a C-141 after prompting by the OCD.

Additionally, you have not completed corrective action for the release as required by OCD Rule 19.15.29 NMAC. On September 25, 2009, the OCD District 2 Office sent you a copy of the attached letter that required you to submit a corrective action work proposal (plan) for the release by October 16, 2009. You did not respond to the letter and provide the required corrective action work proposal (plan).

IV. Violation of Water Quality Control Commission Rules

a. Discharging Without a Permit

Water Quality Control Commission (WQCC) Rule 20.6.2.3104 NMAC requires that no person shall cause or allow effluent or leachate to discharge so that it may move directly or indirectly into ground water unless he is discharging pursuant to a discharge permit issued by the secretary.

You violated WQCC Rule 20.6.2.3104 NMAC when your company willfully discharged produced water without having a discharge permit.

b. Not Timely Reporting Release or Completing Corrective Action

WQCC Rule 20.6.2.1203 NMAC provides that with respect to any discharge from any facility of oil or other water contaminant, in such quantity as may with reasonable probability injure or be detrimental to human health, animal or plant life, or property, or unreasonable interfere with the public welfare or the use of property, the person in charge of a "facility" ("facility" means any structure, installation, operation, storage tank, transmission line, motor vehicle, rolling stock, or activity of any kind, whether stationary or mobile") shall orally notify the OCD within 24 hours of discovery of the discharge, and provide written notification within one week of discovery. A release reported pursuant to OCD Rule 19.15.29 NMAC would not have to be reported pursuant to WQCC Rule 20.6.2.1203 NMAC, since the reporting requirements are not meant to be duplicative of OCD Rule 19.15.29 NMAC. WQCC 20.6.2.1203 requires the owner/operator of the "facility" to complete OCD-approved corrective action.

As described in Section III.c., you did not provide timely notification of the release to the OCD, and have not completed OCD-approved corrective action for the release.

For the reasons described above, the OCD <u>hereby denies</u> your Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water.

You may re-submit a Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water for approval by the OCD once you have completed OCD-approved corrective action for the produced water release described in this letter. Please be advised that approval of your re-submitted Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water remains subject to OCD rules.

YOU ARE NOT AUTHORIZED TO TRANSPORT PRODUCED WATER.

If you transport produced water without an approved Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water, then you will be subject to a court order requiring you to pay civil penalties in the amount of \$1,000 per violation pursuant to Section 70-2-28 and 70-2-31, NMSA 1978, a court order prohibiting you from transporting produced water pursuant to Section 70-2-28, NMSA 1978, and future denial of any Form C-133 Authorization to Move Produced Water.


