Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*  56 barrels of produced water overflowed inside the lined containment at the Trionyx Treatment Facility. Liner was checked for holes and no holes were found; therefore the spill did not touch the pad or leave the lease. A vacuum truck was used to recover the entire spill of 56 barrels of produced water.
