
Hello all, BOPCO has had a release at the Hudson Federal Battery. A total of 40 bbls of mixed fluids (oil and produced water) are estimated to have been released, 20 of which were recovered via vacuum truck. The remaining fluids are estimated as 12 bbls produced water and 8 bbls oil remain in the soil. Most of the leaked fluids were contained within the location berm. An overspray area was issued into the west pasture from the southwest corner of the battery pad. We will submit the initial form C-141. Please call with any questions. Thank you.


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
