Dear Mr. Catanach:

EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its Neptune 10 State Com No. 504H Well to be completed within the Triple X Bone Spring Pool (Pool Code 59900) underlying Sections 3 and 10, Township 24 South, Range 33 West, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 330 feet from the South line and 1,480 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 10. The upper most perforation will be located 330 feet from South line and 1,480 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 10 and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 1,480 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 3. Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than 330 feet to the western, southwestern, and northwestern boundaries of the project area. Ownership in the W/2 W/2 of Sections 3 and 10 is common with the proposed spacing unit and therefore there are no affected parties in the spacing unit to the West. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow EOG to use their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste. EOG is the operator of existing horizontal wells in the adjacent spacing units to the East and to the West, and this well spacing will be a continuation of EOG's preferred well spacing for their development plan in the area.

Exhibit A is a draft Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed Neptune 10 State Com No. 504H Well encroaches on the spacing and proration units to the West, Northwest, and Southwest.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Sections 3 and 10 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed Neptune 10 State Com No. 504H Well in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.

Exhibit C is a list of the parties affected by the encroachment to the Northwest, and Southwest. As described above, EOG is the operator in the spacing unit in the W/2 W/2 of Sections 3 and 10 and ownership is identical with that of the subject spacing unit. For these reasons, there are no affected parties in the spacing unit to the West. Parties affected by the unorthodox location are located in the spacing units to the Northwest and the Southwest. Each of these parties have been provided notice of this application by certified mail. A copy of this application has also been provided to the New Mexico State Land Office.

Your attention to this matter is appreciated.




