The combined project area for these wells include the N/2 of Section 10, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

The commingled and gas production from the wells detailed above shall be measured and sold at the Cerf 10 Federal Well No. 3H and Cerf 10 Federal Com. Well No. 4H Central Tank Battery (CTB), located in Unit A, Section 9, Township 21 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Production from the subject wells shall be determined as follows:


The Cerf 10 Federal Com. Well No. 4H oil and gas production shall be metered continuously. The oil and gas production for the Cerf 10 Federal Well No. 3H shall be based on subtraction method.

The allocation meters shall be calibrated quarterly in accordance with Rule 19.15.12.10.C (2).

The operator shall notify the Artesia District office of the Division prior to implementation of the commingling operations.
