Assignment of allowable and allocation of production from the subject well shall continue to be reported in the identical methods in the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) as the previous White City; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool. The White City; Penn (Gas) assignment of allowable and allocation of production shall remain unchanged.

Pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.12.11B. NMAC, the commingling authority granted herein may be rescinded by the Division Director if conservation is not being best served by such commingling.
