Reference is made to your application received on April 21, 2017.

You have requested approval of an unorthodox oil well location described above in the referenced pool or formation. This location is governed by the Special Rules for the Escrito Gallup (Associated) Pool, which provide for 80-acre units with wells to be located at least 790 feet from outer unit boundaries, and Rule 19.15.16.14.B(2) NMAC concerning directional wells in designated project areas. This surface location is outside the project area, and is permitted by Rule 19.15.16.15.B (4) NMAC which allows for surface locations outside project area. This location is unorthodox because portions of the proposed completed interval are closer to outside boundaries

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It is our understanding that Logos Operating, LLC is seeking this location because the generally accepted industry practice in the Escrito Gallup (Associated) Pool and other Gallup pools is to develop the project area within 330 feet of the outer boundaries. Further, Logos Operating, LLC is planning to develop the S/2 N/2 of Section 15 and the S/2 NE/4 of Section 16 with the Escrito D14 2407 Com Well No. 2H.

Your application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rules 19.15.15.13 NMAC and 19.15.4.12.A (2) NMAC.

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Division Rule 19.15.15.13 (B) NMAC, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.

The above approvals are subject to your being in compliance with all other applicable Division rules, including, but not limited to Division Rule 19.15.5.9 NMAC.

Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
