EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Antietam 9 Fed Com No. 704H Well** to be completed within the WC-025 G-09 S253309A; Upper Wolfcamp (Pool Code 98180) underlying Sections 9 and 16, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 164 feet from the North line and 2,033 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 9. The <u>upper most perforation</u> will be located <u>330 feet from North line and 1,365 feet</u> from the West line (Unit C) of Section 9 and the lower most perforation will be 2,310 feet from the North line and 1,363 feet from the West line (Unit D) of Section 16. Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than 330 feet to the western, southwestern, and northwestern boundaries of the project area.

Ownership is identical in the W/2 of Section 9 and the NW/4 of Section 16. EOG has permitted and will be the operator of three wells dedicated to the W/2 W/2 of Section 9 and the W/2 NW/4 of Section 16: the Antietam 9 Fed Com No. 701H, the Antietam 9 Fed Com No. 702H, and the Antietam 9 Fed Com No. 703H. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow EOG to use their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste.





 - I am a Registered Professional Petroleum Engineer in the State of Texas.
 - I was hired by EOG Resources, Inc. in 2004. I have been employed in various capacities utilizing my petroleum engineering background for approximately 40 years.
- 5. For the past 10 years, I have worked exclusively in unconventional reservoir development, including the last year in the Permian Basin.
- 6. I have been a member of the Society of Petroleum Engineers since 1977.
 - I am familiar with the reservoir in Sections 9 & 16, Township 25 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and have reviewed the administrative application for an unorthodox location filed by my attorney in connection with the Antietam 9 Fed Com #704H well.
 - Based upon EOG's records, ownership is common in the W2 of Section 9 and the NW of Section 16 Township 25 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
