EOG Resources, Inc. (OGRID No. 7377) seeks administrative approval of an unorthodox well location for its **Neptune 10 State Com No. 704H Well** to be completed within the WC-025 G-09 S243310P; Upper Wolfcamp (Pool Code 98135) underlying Section 3 and 10, Township 24 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. This well will be drilled from a surface location 629 feet from the South line and 2,012 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 10. The upper most perforation will be located 330 feet from South line and 1,590 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 10 and the lower most perforation will be 330 feet from the North line and 1,590 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 3. Since this acreage is governed by the Division's statewide rules which provides for wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to the outer boundary of the spacing unit, the completed interval for this well will be unorthodox because it is closer than 330 feet to the western, southwestern, and northwestern boundaries of the project area.

EOG will be the operator of the Neptune 10 State Com No. 702H Well, a proposed Wolfcamp well located in the W/2 W/2 of Sections 3 and 10. EOG is the operator of the Neptune 10 State Com No. 701H Well, an existing Wolfcamp well located in the W/2 S/W and S/W N/W of Section 3 and the W/2 W/2 of Section 10. The working interest ownership is identical in the W/2 W/2 and the E/2 W/2 of Sections 3 and 10. Approval of the unorthodox completed interval will allow EOG to use their preferred well spacing plan for horizontal wells in this area and thereby prevent waste.

Exhibit A is a draft Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat (Form C-102), which shows that the completed interval of the proposed **Neptune 10 State Com No. 704H Well** encroaches on the spacing and proration units to the West, Northwest, and Southwest.

Exhibit B is a land plat for Sections 3 and 10 and the surrounding sections that shows the proposed **Neptune 10 State Com No. 704H Well** in relation to adjoining units and existing wells.

Exhibit C is a list of the parties affected by the encroachment to the Northwest and Southwest. As described above, ownership throughout the W/2 of Sections 3 and 10 is identical. Accordingly, there are no affected parties in the spacing units to the West of the proposed well. Each of the parties listed on Exhibit C have been provided notice of this application by certified mail. A copy of this application has been provided to the Bureau of Land Management-Carlsbad Office.




