Burlington Resources is applying for administrative approval of action the Basin Fruitland Coal. The subject well was staked at this location due to steep terrain, archaeology sites and future development of the surrounding area within the legal spacing window for the formations. The surface owner requested this location for a less visual impact, as well as noise abatement for the future development of this pristine area. As a result, no suitable location could be found within the window. Consequently, this location was staked non-standard for these formations to best fit the terrain, archeology and alleviate any surface owner concerns.


