N/A Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* An underground steel flowline failed causing a release of crude oil and produced water. The		
amounts were originally determined to be below the reportable threshold and the visually impacted area was excavated with the soil hauled to a NMOCD approved disposal facility. When vegetation had not reestablished by March of 2017, it was determined that further sampling was necessary.		
Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* An approximate area of 100 feet by 40 feet is impacted. Soil samples have been collected down to		
50 feet bgs for vertical delineation and the east side of the release has been found horizontally. Due to remaining pipelines within the release area, sidewall sampling will be conducted to determine the north, south, and west horizontal extents during the time of excavation with confirmation sampling conducted		
prior to backfilling.
