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Dear Mr. Stone:

Under the provisions of General Rule 111 (c), (d) and (e), Grynberg Petroleum Company on behalf of Celeste C. Grynberg made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on October 2, 1989, for authorization to sidetrack, re-enter, recomplete and directionally drill its Isler "3" Federal Well No. 1, Chaves County, New Mexico.

The Division Director Finds That:

- (1) The application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 11 (d) and (e) of the Division General Rules and Regulations;
- (2) Satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators have been duly notified;
- (3) The applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in General Rule 111 will be met; and
- (4) No objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The applicant, Grynberg Petroleum Company on behalf of Celeste C. Grynberg, is hereby authorized to re-enter the previously plugged and abandoned Isler "3" Federal Well No. 1 located at a standard surface gas well location 660 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 3, Township 10 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, Chaves County, New Mexico, and recomplete into the Oasis Abo Gas Pool by sidetracking from a depth of approximately 6800 feet and directionally drill in such

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a manner as to bottom to a true vertical depth of approximately 7500 feet at a target point of 760 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of said Section 3. However, the new bottomhole location for this well shall not exceed beyond the prescribed area for a standard location for said pool in the NE/4 NW/4 of said Section 3.

PROVIDED HOWEVER THAT: prior to directional drilling, the operator shall determine the subsurface location of the kick-off point; and

PROVIDED FURTHER THAT: subsequent to the above-described directional drilling, should said well be a producer, a continuous multi-shot directional survey shall be made of the wellbore from total depth to kick-off point with shot points not more than 100 feet apart; the operator shall cause the surveying company to forward a copy of the survey report directly to the Santa Fe office of the Division, 310 Old Santa Fe Trail, Room 206, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87503, and the operator shall notify the Division's Hobbs District Office of the date and time said survey is to be commenced.


(2) Form C-105 shall be filed in accordance with Division Rule 1105 and the operator shall indicate thereon true vertical depth in addition to measured depths.

(3) The NW/4 of said Section 3 shall be dedicated to the well form a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

(4) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
