Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of May 22, 1962, requesting that the Commission approve a tubing setting depth of from 3000 to 3500 feet for your Meta Schmidt Well No. 1, Jenkins Wolfcamp Pool, Lea County, New Mexico. The tubing is currently set at a depth of 7000 feet under authority of Administrative Order TX-5.

Due to the severity of the water producing problem encountered in this well, and in recognition of the fact that future additional tubing setting changes may be desired, your Meta Schmidt is hereby exempt from the tubing setting requirement of Rule 107 (d) 3. The only requirement will be that Form C-103, Miscellaneous Reports, be filed with the Hobbs office of the Commission reporting any future change in tubing setting depth.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of January 18, 1961, requesting permission to raise the tubing seat in your Meta Schmidt Well No. 1, Jenkins Wolfcamp Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to approximately 7,000 feet and eliminate the packer.

Dear Sir:

We are now pumping this well from a depth of 5700' with tubing seat at 9631' open ended, and packer set at 9591' with 5½" casing seat at 9785'. Perforations are from 9626.5 to 9627.5. Our average production is 10 to 15 barrels oil and 235 barrels water per day.

We are in the process of setting a larger pumping unit capable of pumping from 7000' to increase production.

We would like permission to raise the tubing seat in this well to approximately 7000' and eliminate the packer. We believe this would give us better pumping efficiency and also cut down on our operating cost.

Dear Sir:

On January 18, 1961 we requested permission to raise the tubing in the above subject well from 9631 to 7000' in order to give us better pumping efficiency and also cut operating costs. We received your approval on Feb. 22, 1961 and have been pumping the well with tubing bottomed at approximately 7000' since that time.

For the past several months the oil production has been decreasing and the water production has been increasing.

May (1 thru 16)	384	19	3464

We request permission to raise the tubing seat from 7000' to between 3000 and 3500' in an attempt to increase the oil production by pumping from nearer the fluid level in the well. The fluid level on April 16 was 1644'.

The above request is being made in an effort to put the well on an economic basis in order to eliminate the necessity of plugging and abandoning.
