Dear Ms. Bradfield:

Reference is made to your application dated May 7, 1990 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing San Juan 27-8C Unit Well No. 6 which was drilled in 1957 and completed in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location 1650 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit E) of Section 11, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Pictured Cliffs zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, is unorthodox. Further, the W/2 of said Section 11 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, the abovedescribed unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
