Reference is made to your application dated June 9, 1999, requesting authorization to down hole commingle gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons from the Mesaverde and Dakota formations in the above referenced well. After reviewing the production characteristics in both formations, we concur with the fixed allocation factors established in your application. Authorization is hereby given to allocate production in accordance with the factors outlined below:

<u>Formation</u>	<u>Gas</u>	<u>Oil</u>
Mesaverde	62%	0.0%
Dakota	38%	100.0%

Commingled production from each zone must be reported in accordance with these established allocation factors. The effective date of commingling will be the date commingling first occurs.
