## RE: Injection Pressure Increase Salty Dog Well No. 6 San Juan County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Erwin:

Reference is made to your request received by the Division on July 14, 2006, to increase the surface injection pressure on the Salty Dog Well No. 6. This request is based on a step rate test conducted on the well on July 7, 2006. The results of the step rate test show that an increase in the surface injection pressure for this well is justified and will not result in the fracturing of the injection formation and confining strata.

You are therefore authorized to increase the surface injection pressure on the following well:

The Division Director may rescind this injection pressure increase if it becomes apparent that the injected fluid is not being confined to the injection zone or is endangering any fresh water aquifers.
