Reference is made to the following: (i) your application dated August 14, 2002 (application reference No. pKRV0-223248749), which was received by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("Division") in Santa Fe on August 19, 2002; and (ii) the Division's records in Santa Fe: all concerning Mack Energy Corporation's ("Mack Energy") request for a non-standard 27.71-acre oil spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Empire-Yeso Pool (96210):
