

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*  
**The source of the release was a hole in a 300 barrel crude oil storage tank that was believed to be the result of corrosion on the crude oil storage tank. Approximately 230 barrels of crude oil was released into the storage tank secondary containment dike located at the Geronimo Federal Battery #3.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*  
**Approximately 230 barrels of crude oil was released into the storage tank secondary containment dike located at the Geronimo Federal Battery #3. As per Mr. Raymond Dodd, Wagner Oil Company, approximately 185 barrels of the released crude oil was removed from the storage tank secondary containment dike via vacuum truck with the remaining crude oil having been absorbed by the soil. Mr. Dodd further stated that the contaminated soil would be removed from the affected areas, mixed with fresh soil, left to sit temporarily, and then hauled off for proper disposal. In addition, Mr. Larry Johnson, Oil Conservation Division – Hobbs District Office, requested that a soil delineation be conducted at the incident location.**
