Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a non-standard well location for your Daughtry et al Well No. 1, to be located 1980 feet from the North line and 1830 feet from the East line and in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, a wildcat, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the request for such exception is based upon topographic condition and the location of a state highway in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the only offset operator, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) for the above unorthodox well location.
