Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Lockhart "B-11" Well No. 3-E to be located 1980 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the West line and in the SW/4 NW/4 of Section 11, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Blinbry Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is due to recompletion of a well drilled to another horizon.

Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3, of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blinbry Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-610, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 of Order R-610 for the above described unorthodox well location.
