Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your J. N. Carson Well No. 2 located 2175 feet from the North line and 990 feet from the East line of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, Tubb and Blinebry Gas Pools, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is occasioned by the recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Tubb and Blinebry Gas Pools, as set forth in Orders 586 and 610, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 of Orders 586 and 610 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
