Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your Lamar Lunt B-1 Well located 330 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the East line and in the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, Jalmat Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is occasioned by the recompletion of a well previously drilled to another horizon.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Jalmat Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-520, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 2 of Order R-520 for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey, if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
