Dear Mr. Porter:

This is a request for administrative approval for an unorthodox gas well location in the Basin Dakota Pool.

It is intended to locate the well, El Paso Natural Gas Company Florence "C" No. 10, 2172 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of Section 30, Township 28 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico. The E/2 of Section 30 is dedicated to this well.

As shown on the enclosed plat, the NE/4 of Section 30 consists of rock ledges. The only accessible land for a well in the NE/4 is that which makes the location unorthodox. It is, therefore planned to make the location unorthodox in order that the extremely high cost of constructing an orthodox location be avoided.

Since El Paso Natural Gas Co. holds all offset leases, the consent to said location has not been sought from any other operators.

I am enclosing two copies of the certified well location plat, and two copies of the intention to drill.

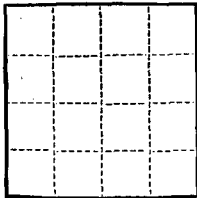

DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to drill a well with rotary tools thru the Dakota formation and to perforate & fracture possible producing zones. Est. T. D. 6838'

Casing Program:

- 9 5/8" @ 280 with 300 sacks cement circulated to surface.
- 4 1/2" @ 6838' with 2 stage tool 100' below base of Point Lookout & 3 stage tool 100' below base of Pictured Cliffs.
- 1st stage - 360 sks. - 150% to cover 100' above Gallup top.
- 2nd stage - 190 sks. - 150% to cover 100' above Cliff House top.
- 3rd stage - 130 sks. - 150% to cover 100' above Fruitland top.

The E/2 of Section 30 is dedicated to this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

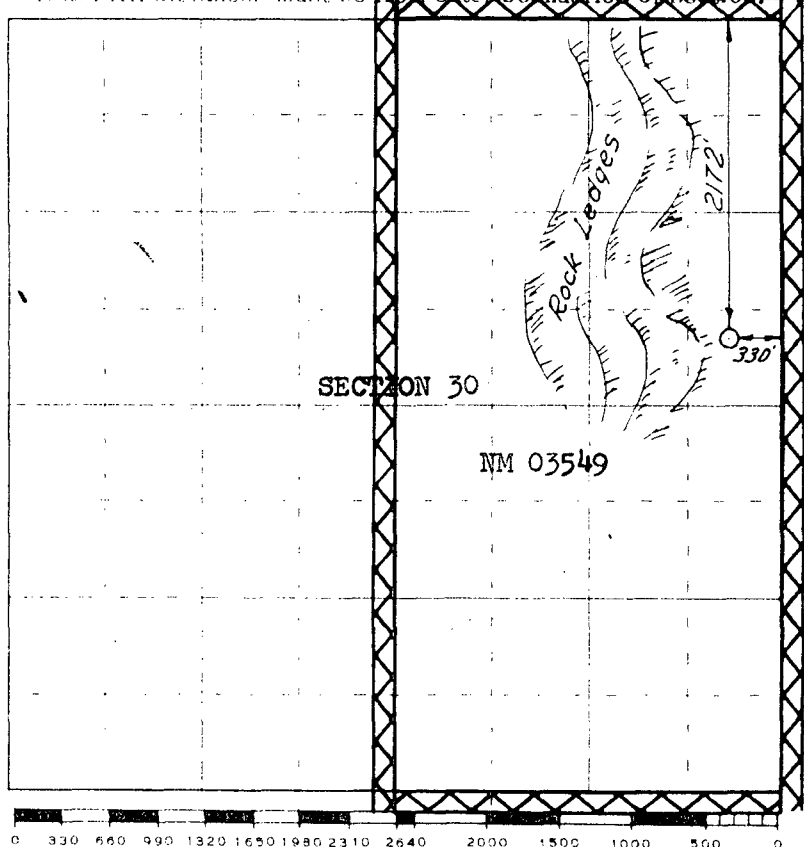
