Pursuant to Rule 3 of Order R-1670-C, Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits, in triplicate, its application for administrative approval of an exception to the well location regulation set forth in Rule 2 of said Order.

In support of this application, Applicant respectfully states and shows the following:

1. The proposed unorthodox drilling location has been staked nine hundred and sixty-five feet (965') from the North line and one thousand nine hundred sixty-five feet (1965') from the West line of Section 7, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M., and this unorthodox location is necessitated by extreme topographical conditions.

2. Gas Producers Corporation, 1201 Main Street, Dallas, Texas, is the only operator of offsetting leases and leases within the section, as indicated by Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. Said operator has been furnished a copy of this application by certified mail, along with a request that it waive notice and hearing and consent to such unorthodox location.


