Pennzoil United, Inc. plans to plug back and re-complete in the Abo formation in the State Sale No. 1 well, which was originally drilled and completed in the Wolfcamp formation. The well is located as described above and will be placed in the North Vacuum-Abo Pool. The pool rules requires that a well be located within 150 feet of the center of either the NW/4 or SE/4 of the quarter section, and our well is located in the center of the SW/4 of the quarter section thus creating an unorthodox location.
