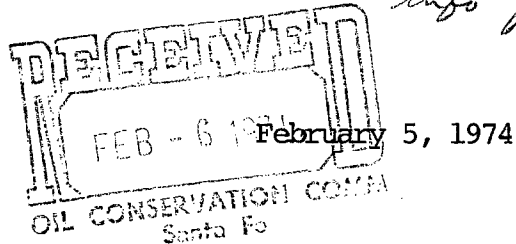

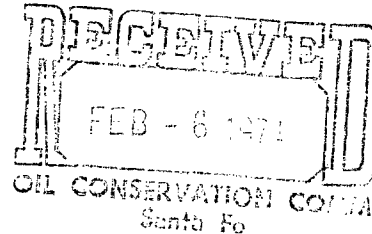

The above location has been permitted with U.S.G.S. and Form C-102, well location and acreage dedication plat, has been submitted to the Commission. Subsequent to surveying and staking the location, a power line was erected which falls approximately 100 feet south of our location. In order to keep a safe distance from the power line, it will be necessary to move the location 150 feet north, placing the location 1830' FNL and 1980' FWL of Section 1, T-23-S, R-30-E. Your approval for this non-standard location, therefore, is hereby requested.

A sketch showing the revised location, offset operators, and the approximate position of the power line is attached. Waiver letters have been requested from all offset operators. If additional information is required, please advise.

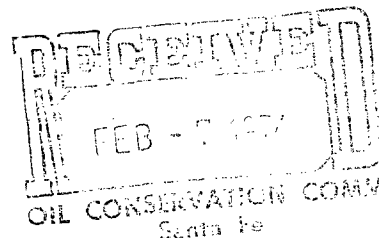

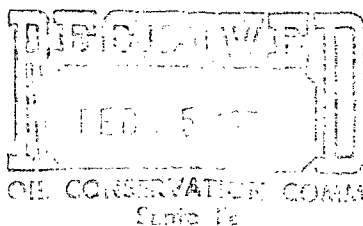
