Dear Mr. Porter:

On or about July 15, 1974, Franklin, Aston & Fair, Inc. plans to re-enter the Texas Pacific USA Woolley "A" #2 Abo dry hole located 1750' FWL & 890' FSL of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 30 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. This was an orthodox location for the Abo formation, drilled to 7,000', and abandoned as a dry hole in the Abo formation. It has 8 5/8" casing set at 3,575' with 2,650 sacks of cement circulated to surface. We plan to re-enter this well and pressure test the 8 5/8" casing. If the casing holds pressure, we plan to drill the cement plug in the base of the 8 5/8" casing, as well as the other cement plugs and deepen the well from 7,000' to 11,400' to test the Pennsylvanian Morrow sands. We, therefore, request administrative approval of an unorthodox Morrow sand location in accordance with Rule 104-F of the State of New Mexico Oil & Gas Commission Rules & Regulations, Revised December 1, 1971.

As shown by the attached map, the offset leaseholders to the South in, Section 28, Atlantic Richfield Company, Anadarko, and General American, are participants in the Loco Hills Morrow Unit. In personal telephone conversation they have stated they have no objection to the unorthodox location, and will forward to the Commission waivers to this effect.

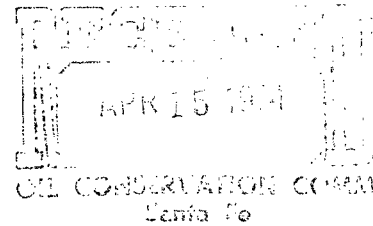

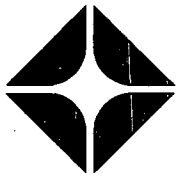

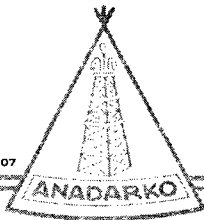
