Your approval is requested for unorthodox locations for two of our proposed gas wells, the Ojo-He-He #3 (1960' FSL - 990' FWL), and the Ojo-He-He #5 (1905' FSL - 1853' FEL). Both wells are in Section 33, Township 27 North, Range 13 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The reason for our request is that these wellsites are within the Navajo Indian Irrigation Project and they have planned their sprinkler system in this area. We have located the wells at the turning point of the sprinkler system so that they will interfere as little as possible with the planned sprinkler system. Our planning was done in conjunction with Mr. J. Y. Christiansen of the Bureau of Indian Affairs here in Farmington. These locations will also result in shorter pipelines and less interference with the Navajo Indian Irrigation Project.
