Pursuant to Rule 104-F of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations, this is to serve as our application for administrative approval of the following described unorthodox location for a Pennsylvanian test.

This location was originally spotted 1650' FN and 1650' FW Lines, Sec. 22, T24S, R26E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This particular site located the well in a draw. The Bureau of Land Management along with the Environmental Agency requested we move the well location 250' north to avoid erosional damage to the surrounding terrain.

On June 18, 1975, a field inspection was conducted by BLM concerning your application for a permit to drill gas well 1-Federal "22", T. 24 South, R. 26 East, Sec. 22.

Your original staked location, 1650/N & W, poses problems as it falls in the center of a small drainage. This particular location is not only inadequate from a surface protection standpoint, but might also prove economically unfeasible for you. By moving your location approximately 250' N, you would not only be on level ground, but would also eliminate the need for a new road as this location falls adjacent to your existing lease road.
