Marathon Oil Company, as Applicant, and as Operator for a group of lessees who have voluntarily formed the South Newmill Drilling Unit in Chaves County, New Mexico, hereby requests that it be granted approval for an unorthodox wildcat gas well location as an exception to the location requirements of the Statewide Rules.

The well in question is the Marathon Oil Company, et al-State "27" Well No. 1, which was permitted and drilled as a wildcat oil well at an orthodox location to the Montoya Formation in a remote part of Chaves County, New Mexico. The specific location of the well was Unit M, located 660 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 27, T-4-S, R-27-E, Chaves County, New Mexico. The well was completed in the Montoya Formation, but after a test was found unproductive and was recompleted in the Strawn Formation as a gas well, hence the unorthodox location. It is proposed the W/2 of Section 27 be assigned as a proration unit for this well.

In the event that this application can be handled administratively under the provisions of Rule 104, Section F, as an exception to Section B thereof, please advise the undersigned and waivers from offset operators, who in this case are in fact participants in the 3,440.56 acre South Newmill Drilling Unit, can be furnished. If this request cannot be so processed administratively, please set this matter for a hearing on the earliest available hearing docket and issue the appropriate notices required by the rules. 
