All of the orthodox locations fall either in a lake or on intolerably steep slopes surrounding the lake. Construction and operation of a drill site on any of the orthodox locations would result in considerable surface damage being done. Also, a continuing and recurring damage and inconvenience would be experienced in the course of operating a producing well.

Mr. Blackford owns and operates the properties on three sides of the proposed location.

Mr. Thomas A. Dugan, Dugan Production Corp. owns the north offset. Mr. Dugan has been properly notified of our intent and expresses no objection to our proposed location.




