

2. A topographic plat showing location of the standard location at 45 feet east of an irrigation concrete ditch and a higher bench. By moving the location east 100 feet we are still in the lower bench and will incur much lesser damage to the farmland and irrigation system. The access road would be from the east off of a pavement.


