Dear Mr. Freeman:

You have contacted our office regarding the location of two proposed gas wells within the Navajo Indian Irrigation Project.

To prevent interference with the designed irrigation systems of the Project we request that the wells be located as follows:

- Delhi Taylor #6E, 990' FNL, 1450' FWL, Sec. 17,
T. 26 N., R. 11 W..
- ✓ Delhi Taylor #5E, 2350' FSL, 990' FEL, Sec. 17,
T. 26 N., R. 11 W..

To locate the wells other than these locations would create problems in both access to your wells and operation of the sprinkler irrigation systems. All production equipment should be installed north of the actual well sites.
