APPLICATION

COMES NOW, U. S. Companies, Inc. and states:

- 1. The name of the Applicant is U. S. Companies, Inc. and its address is 4560 Belt Line Road, Suite 300, Dallas, Texas 75234.
- 2. Applicant is the owner of State Oil and Gas Lease LG-7655 issued 1 February 1980 covering the following lands in Lea County, New Mexico:

Township 18 South, Range 32 East:

Section 32: N_2 , containing 320 acres, more or less.

- 3. Applicant desires to drill a well projected to a depth of 13,000 feet to the Morrow Formation, which is the common source of supply for the area affected.
- 4. Applicant first planned to drill the well 1,980 feet from the north line and 1,980 feet from the east line of said section, which would be an orthodox location. However, Applicant has discovered that El Paso Natural Gas Company has a pipeline easement traversing the W_2 of the NE $_4$ of said section from north to south and the standard location would encroach on said pipeline easement.
- 5. For the reasons stated above, Applicant desires approval of a location to be 1,980 feet from the north line and 1,780 feet from the east line of said section. A plat showing the survey by Gary D. Boswell, a registered professional engineer, is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".
- 6. It is necessary that the location be moved so that the pads and pits of the proposed well will not encroach on the pipeline easement.






