Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a non-standard location for your Empire South Deep Unit No. 22 located 888 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the West line of Section 31, Township 17 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Wolfcamp Pennsylvanian formation, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate an existing 297-acre proration unit, previously approved by NSP-983, and comprising the N/2 of said Section 31 to your Empire South Deep Unit No. 22 as described above and your Empire South Deep Unit No. 5 located 1980 feet from the North line and 2180 feet from the East line of said Section 31. Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable from any of the wells on the proration unit in any proportion.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 F of the Division Rules and Regulations, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
