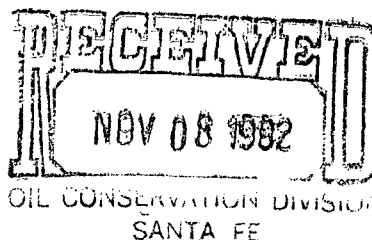

Anadarko Production Company requests administrative approval to drill the following 4 wells at unorthodox locations within the Unit boundary of our Teas Yates Unit, Teas Yates - Seven Rivers Pool, Lea County, New Mexico:

I hereby certify that these wells are needed to permit the completion of an efficient production and injection pattern within an existing waterflood established by Order Number R-4077 dated December 8th, 1970 and expanded by Order Number R-7084 dated September 30th, 1982. I also certify that none of these wells will be drilled any closer than 330 feet from an exterior unit boundary and that no well will be drilled any closer than 10 feet to any quarter-quarter section line or subdivision inner boundary, as provided for in State Wide Rule 104-F.

The two operators of immediate offset proration unit, Grace Petroleum Corp. and Union Texas Exploration Corp. (wells 11-2 and 2-3) have been notified by registered, return receipt requested letter dated this date. No other well is within a 40 acre proration unit of the Unit boundary. (see attached plat).
