Santa Fe Energy, Exploration Department, is proposing an unorthodox location (990' FEL, 990' FNI) in Section 28, T22S, R27E, Eddy County, New Mexico. Reasons for this location are as follows:


- Isopaching of clean Morrow Sands indicates the trend of sand reservoirs trends in a northwestsoutheast direction.
- (2) A cumulative gas production map of the Morrow sands indicates best production is oriented in a northwestsoutheast direction. This information supports the Morrow sand isopach (Map 1).
- (3) The Morris Antweil #1 Randall (1980' FNL and 1980' FSL) Section 21, T22S, R27E is a poor well. It was plugged in 1976 after producing 49,612,000 CFG. Santa Fe Energy's proposed location would be 3700' southeast and 3000' south of the productive Santa Fe #1 Walker.
 - (4) The Santa Fe #1 Walker (990' FEL, 1980' FSL Section 21) encountered an excellent Morrow reservoir. The well potentialed for 8.4 million cubic feet of gas per day, CAOF).


