El Paso Natural Gas Company has requested administrative approval for an unorthodox location in the Blanco Mesa Verde pool.


It is intended to locate the El Paso Natural Gas Company's San Juan 27-4 Unit #152 at 1300' from the South line and 1350' from the West line of Section 3, T-27-N, R-4-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

Extremely rough terrain in the form of cliffs and ledges along the western edge of this section makes it impossible to build an orthodox gas well location.

In compliance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Division rules, we are notifying you, as operator of an offsetting proration unit, of our application for administrative approval for the aforementioned unorthodox gas well location. 


