Gentlemen:

In the near future, we plan to file a 9-331C and C-102 with the Bureau of Land Management District Office in Carlsbad for permission to drill a new Jalmat gas well as a Section 103 infill well at a non-standard location consisting of 330' FSL & 660' FWL Section 4, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The Wells Federal No. 18 must necessarily be drilled at an unorthodox location because the proration unit is criss-crossed by numerous powerlines, high pressure gas lines, and flowlines. The sketch attached to this letter shows the various obstacles in detail.

The subject well will be drilled on an existing 120-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit comprised of the N/2 SW/4 & SW/4 SW/4 Section 4. At the present, the subject 120-acre tract is dedicated to the El Paso Natural Gas Company-operated (soon to be Doyle Hartman-operated) Wells Federal No. 3 (K-4-25S-37E) which is a Jalmat (Gas) producer, and upon the drilling and completion of the newly proposed Wells Federal No. 18, both the Wells Federal No. 3 and the Wells Federal No. 18 will be simultaneously dedicated to the existing 120-acre proration unit consisting of the N/2 SW/4 & SW/4 SW/4 Section 4.

Therefore, we hereby file for administrative approval to simultaneously dedicate the new infill well (Wells Federal No. 18) along with the Wells Federal No. 3 to the existing 120-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas)

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proration unit comprised of the N/2 SW/4 & SW/4 SW/4 Section 4, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico.

Furthermore, if the proposed well is completed as a commercial producer and in compliance with the Natural Gas Policy of 1978, an application will also be submitted to the Bureau of Land Management to obtain administrative approval for the well as a Section 103 infill well.

Three copies of a land plat showing the location of the original Jalmat (Gas) well on the 120-acre proration unit plus the non-standard location of the proposed new infill well are also enclosed.

Copies of the enclosed application have also been sent by certified mail to the offsetting party owning Jalmat Gas rights. The following is a list of the offsetting Jalmat Gas owner:

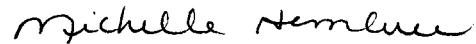

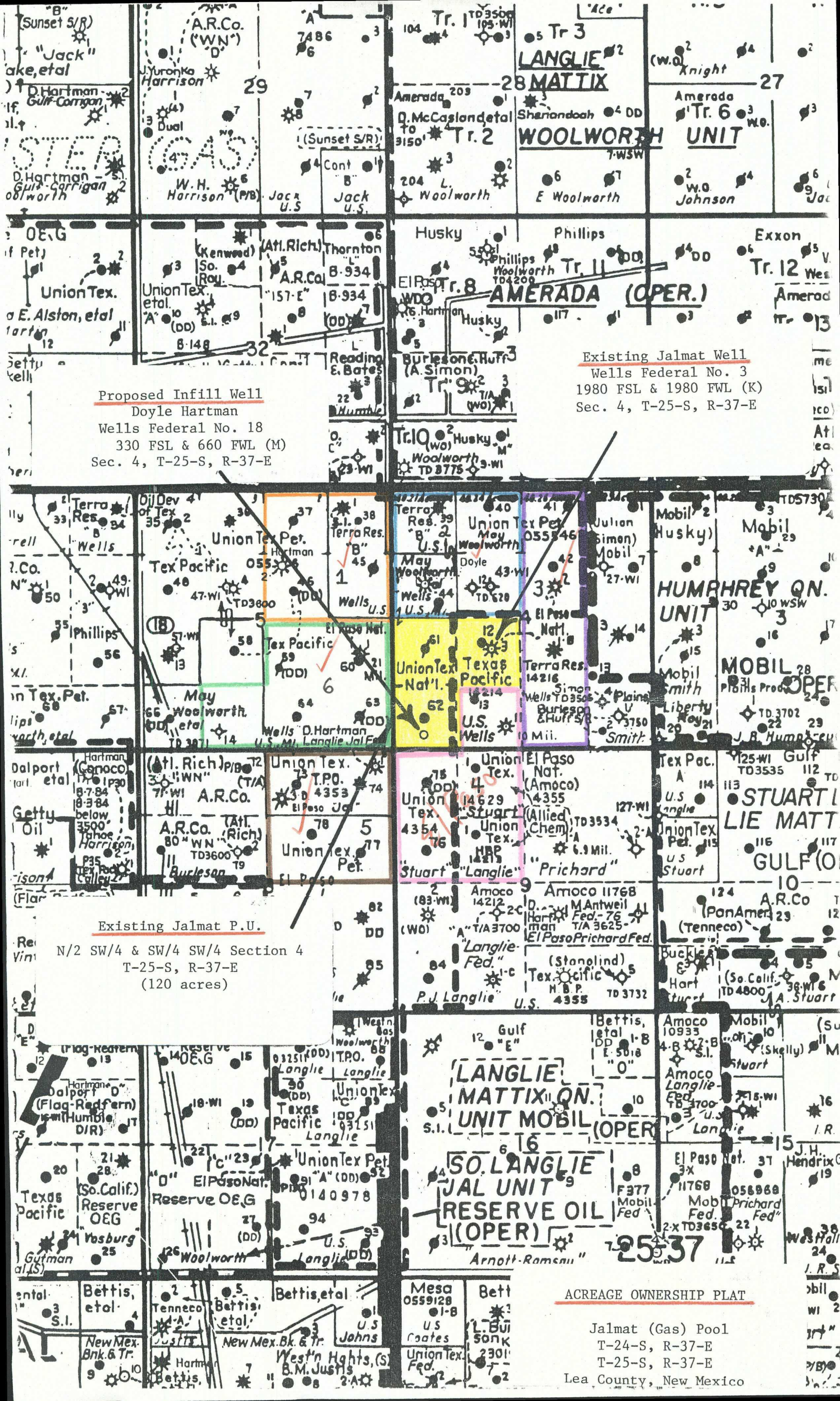

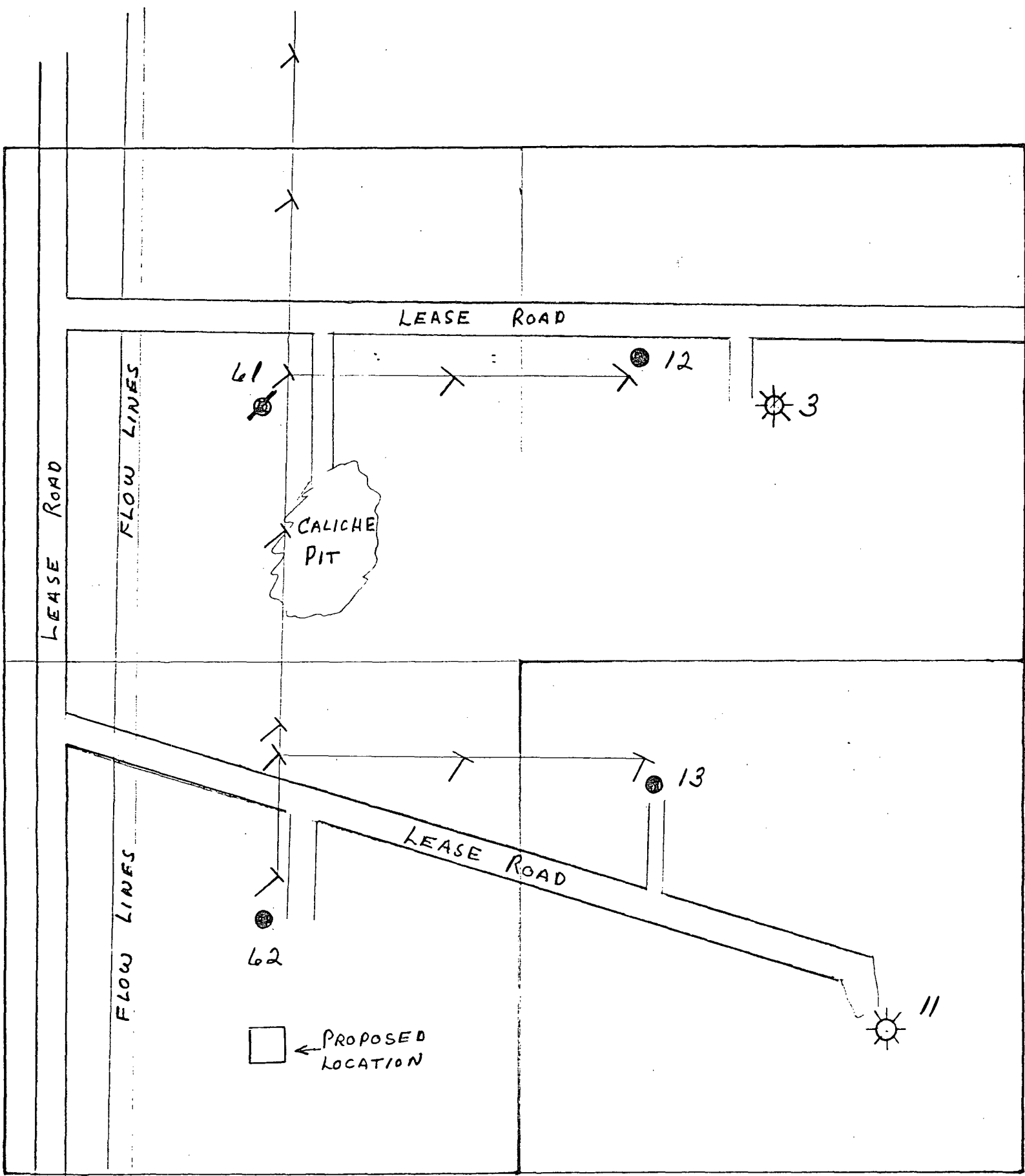
