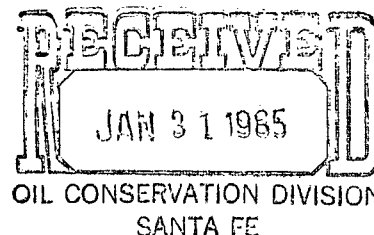

We will appreciate your expeditious approval and issuance of the administrative order.

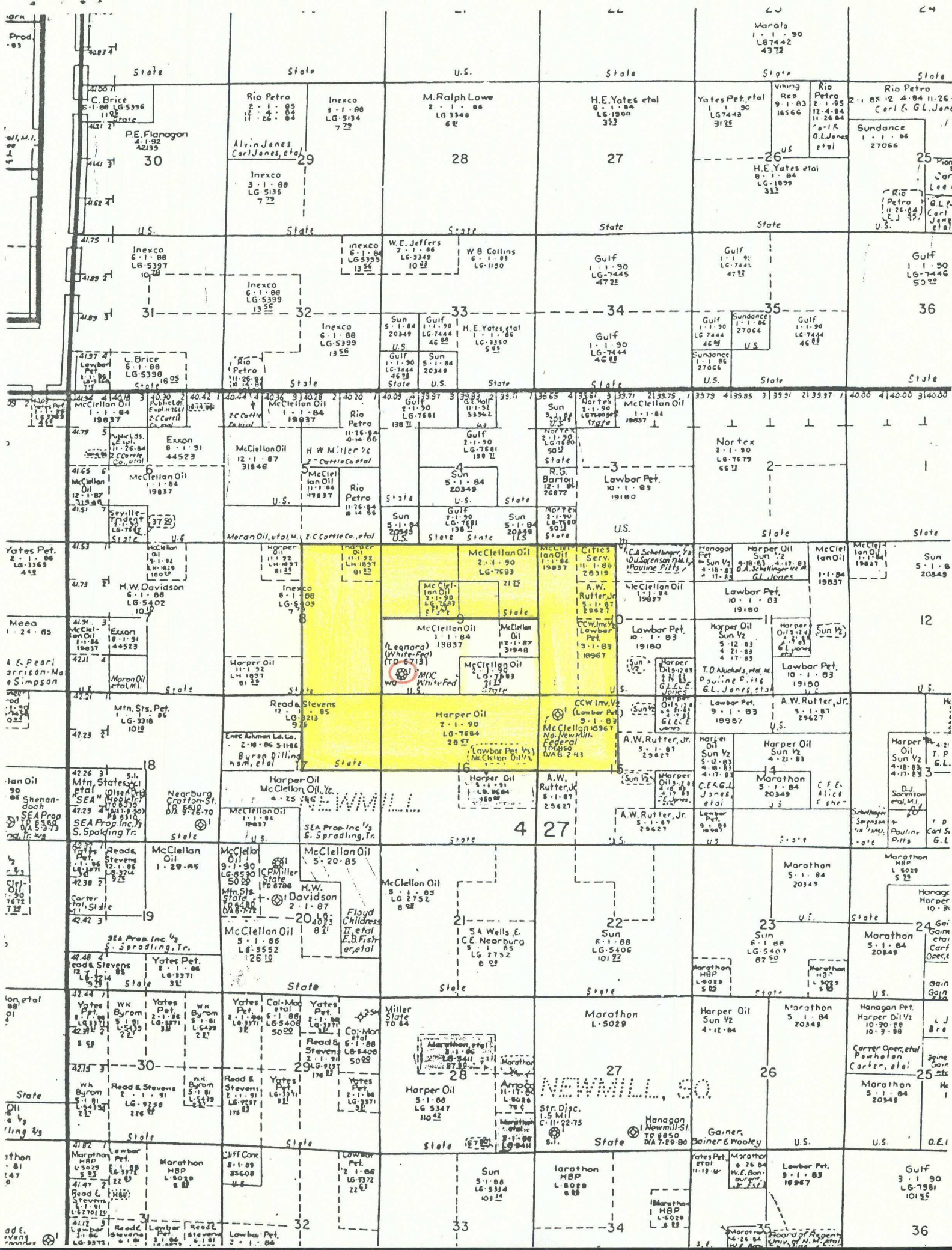

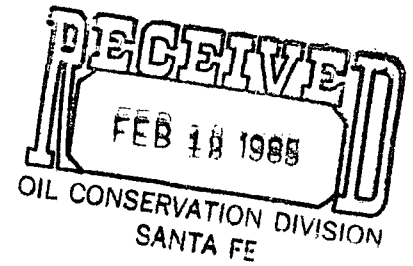


